

June 8, 2011:

Resolutely Against Anti-Semitism

The parliamentary group "DIE LINKE" in the German Bundestag [parliament] passed the following resolution:

The members of DIE LINKE parliamentary group will take action against all forms of anti-Semitism in the society also in the future. There is no room for rightwing extremism and anti-Semitism in our party, today or at anytime. Therefore, the parliamentary group DIE LINKE is resolutely opposed to anti-Semitic ideas and rightwing extremist actions.

In all its diversity of opinions and with accent on the May 21, 2011 declaration against Anti-Semitism by DIE LINKE party executive committee, the members of the parliamentary group in the German Bundestag declare the following:

We will neither participate in initiatives on the Middle East Conflict calling for a one-state solution for Palestine and Israel, calling for boycotts against Israeli products nor in this year's "Gaza Flotilla".

We expect our personal staff as well as the staff of the parliamentary group to apply these positions.
